

Mount Up & Soar: One Woman's Eagle Story The Woman in the Synagogue

Scripture base: Luke 13:10-17

1) The enemy has been trying to bind up and oppress women since the Garden of Eden...but Jesus!

Is there a bondage still gripping me and forcing me to keep my head down and my eyes off of the future...my victory, goals, dreams, joy...?

2) Jesus thought 18 years was way too long for a covenant daughter to be held in bondage - it bothered Him that Satan had a hold on this woman - it was a compassionate, not judgmental, concern for her.

How long have I been held captive by this bondage? Do I realize that Jesus cares about it and wants me free?

3) Jesus knew she could not be free without Him, so He called her to Himself.

Have I heard Jesus calling me into His presence? If so, how?

4) Jesus told her the truth that she didn't realize - she was

already loosed by being in His presence and by being a covenant daughter.

What covenant truth has Jesus declared about me and my situation? (hint: Look in the Word.)

5) Jesus' touch - laying His hands on the woman - brought about the manifestation of her freedom into the natural realm.

How does Jesus lay hands on me now that He is not physically present?
